Myron Welch is Professor of Music and Director of Bands at the University of Iowa where he conducts the Symphony Band and Chamber Wind Ensemble and teaches courses in instrumental methods and conducting Besides being responsible for all band activities at Iowa, he also coordinates the All-State Music Camp.

Prior to coming to Iowa, Dr. Welch was Director of Bands and Coordinator of Music Education at Wright State University, Dayton, Ohio. He was also band and orchestra director at Okemos High School, Okemos, Michigan, where he developed superior ensembles in both mediums. A native of Michigan, he received the Bachelor of Music and Master of Music degrees from Michigan State University, with majors in clarinet and

bassoon. He earned the Doctorate in Music Education from the University of Illinois where he was selected as the first candidate for the Band Conductor Internship Program and studied conducting with Dr. Harry Begian.

Ensembles under his direction have performed at state and national conventions for the Michigan School Band and Orchestra Association, Ohio Music Education Association, Iowa Music Education Association, Iowa Bandmasters Association, College Bandmasters National Association, and the American Bandmasters Association. Dr. Welch was a frequent reviewer of new music for *The Instrumentalist* and is a frequent guest conductor, adjudicator, and clinician. He has appeared with the Goldman Band of New York City and with numerous All-State Bands, Honor Bands, and music camps throughout the country.

Dr. Welch is President of the Iowa Bandmasters Association and is a member of the American Bandmasters Association, National Band Association, Phi Mu Alpha Synfonia, and Music Educators National Conference.
