Dr. Gary Garner began his teaching career in Lubbock, Texas. From there he joined the music faculty at the University of Southern California, where he remained for four years before accepting an appointment at West Texas A & M University. He is currently in his 34th year there, where he is Professor of Music and Director of Bands and Orchestra.

Under Garner's direction, the WTAMU Symphonic Band has achieved national distinction. They have performed a record nine times for the Texas Music Educators Association. They have played twice for national meetings of the College Band Directors National Association and twice at Carnegie Hall, both times to standing ovations. New York Times critic John Rockwell called the band "remarkably accomplished" and their concert "a refreshing change from our own provincial concert fare."

Garner has traveled widely as clinician, guest conductor, and flute soloist. He has recorded two albums of solo flute music and two albums of flute trios, one with sons Brad and Blair and the other with Brad and the eminent American flutist, Julius Baker. He has been the recipient of the WTAMU Faculty Excellence Award, the prestigious Minnie Piper Stevens Award, the Bohumil Makovsky Award from Kappa Kappa Psi and Tau Beta Sigma, and the Gene Hemmle Award from Texas Tech University.

Tim's books, produced by *G.I.A. Publications*, <u>The Art of Successful Teaching</u>, and <u>The Joy of Inspired Teaching</u>, are best sellers in the music profession. He is also co-author of *Hal Leonard's* popular band method, <u>Essential Elements</u>, and the creator and writer of the highly acclaimed <u>Director's Communication Kits</u>.

Tim is a graduate of Ball State University and the University of Alabama. He was recently awarded an Honorary Doctorate Degree from VanderCook College of Music. In November, 1995 Tim was presented with the distinguished *Sudler Order of Merit* from the John Philip Sousa Foundation.
