Dr. David F. Wilborn is Director of Small Ensembles and Associate Professor of Music at Texas A&M University in College Station. He teaches the low brass studio and coordinates all small ensembles. Previously, he served as the Director of Bands at Cameron University, Eastern New Mexico University, and Ft. Hays State University. Wilborn holds the Bachelor of Music degree from the University of Texas at Austin, the Master of Music degree from the Eastman School of Music, and the Doctor of Musical Arts degree from the University of Texas.

Wilborn is past Vice President of the College Division of the New Mexico Music Educators Association. He also served as the New Mexico Chairperson for Collegiate Membership for MENC. He currently serves as a conductor, clinician, presenter and contest adjudicator at numerous educational venues throughout the United States, Puerto Rico, and Europe including: the Italtart Study Abroad Center (Santa Chiara, Italy), International Trombone Association Workshop, Hawaii International Conference on Arts and Humanities, Music Educators National Conference, American Trombone Workshop, College Music Society, National Association of College Wind and Percussion Instructors, Texas Music Educators Association, Texas Bandmasters Association, and the New Mexico Music Educators Association. As a strong advocate of band performance, Wilborn currently hosts a weekly radio show called Time Out for Band for National Public Radio affiliate KAMU FM 90.9. He continues to serve as an honor band clinician and adjudicator at band festivals. His articles have been published in The Instrumentalist, ITA Journal, School Band and Orchestra, NACWPI Journal, The New Mexico Musician, and Teaching Music.

Wilborn is the composer of numerous works for wind and percussion instruments. He is the recipient of multiple ASCAP Plus Awards. His Excursions for Six Trombones was selected as the winner of the 2003 Allen E. Ostrander Trombone Choir Composition Prize; his brass quintet entitled Escapades was selected as one of the winning compositions at the Appalachian State 2004 Brass Chamber Music Festival Composition Contest; and his Three Movements for Brass Sextet won second place at the 2005 Humboldt Composition Contest for Brass Chamber Music. In February 2008, Wilborn performed the trombone solo in the New York premiere of his Concertante Caprice for Bass Trombone and Wind Band with the Texas A&M University Wind Symphony in Carnegie Hall. His music is published by: International Trombone Association Press, C-Alan Publications, Warwick Music, Kagarice Brass Editions, Cherry Classics, Grand Mesa Music and Wehr Music House.

Wilborn's current and past professional affiliations include: The International Trombone Association, College Music Society, National Association of College Wind and Percussion Instructors, Texas Music Educators Association, Texas Bandmasters Association, ASCAP, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonians, Phi Kappa Phi, Kappa Kappa Psi, Tau Beta Sigma, Pi Kappa Lambda, and Phi Beta Mu.

Eugene Migliaro Corporon is the conductor of the Wind Symphony and Regents Professor of Music at the University of North Texas. As Director of Wind Studies he guides all aspects of the program, including the masters and doctoral degrees in Wind Conducting. Mr. Corporon is a graduate of California State University, Long Beach and Claremont Graduate University. His performances have drawn praise from colleagues, composers, connoisseurs and music critics alike. Professor Corporon's career, which spans six decades, began in 1969 as Director of Instrumental Music at Mt. Miguel High School in Spring Valley, California.

He has held collegiate positions since 1971 which include California State University, Fullerton, the University of Wisconsin, the University of Northern Colorado, Michigan State University, the Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music, and the University of North Texas. His ensembles have performed at the Midwest Clinic International Band and Orchestra Conference, Southwestern Music Educators National Conference, Texas Music Educators Association Clinic/Convention, Texas Bandmasters Association Convention/Clinic, National Trumpet Competition,
